Coinline Auction Number 70, July 2007

Welcome to Coinline Auction number 70. A bit of a gap since the last auction, we have been fairly busy. The coin market is extremely bouyant especially in the areas of pre decimal proofs & high grade Commonwealth. Recent public auctions have seen many records fall with some amazing prices paid. The recent Status sale saw a 1933 Shilling achieve \$37,280, an incredible price. The coin would grade MS65 by PCGS standards. I sold a similiar coin (the Ray Jewell coin which has since graded MS65) 12 months ago for \$13,500. Another strong price in this sale was the \$15,145 paid for a 1915H Shilling that would really only make an AU55.

In the last few days I have been pondering the number of Australian coins offered in auction & for sale with major faults. For example in auction recently an Australian Proof Sovereign with a noticable scratch sold for \$75,000 to a postal bidder. Other coins sighted a 1928 shilling gem Unc with a staple scratch, a 1924 threepence with a severe scratch & a 1915 penny desribed as Gem Unc in auction with a long & deep scratch. If you have valuable coins or are purchasing valuable coins why not have them graded? PCGS holders protect your valuable coins. I consider my coins an asset & the same as any other asset I want them protected & looked after.

Now to Coinline 70. We have some fine material from a number of sources. The 1/2 Sovereign collection is Ex Reserve Bank sale lot number 453. It was the first set offered & the best by far. The coins have all been graded by PCGS. The nice aspect about these coins is that they were in the vaults at the bank for over 50 years and are totally original. We also have a nice consignment from a Doctor client who was an active collector in the 1980's. He purchased a lot of material from Canterbury Stamp & Coin auctions a fine source of material in it's day.



We also have on offer a good range of mint product, some better world, a selection of GB, sets & bulk lots and of course some fine PCGS graded coins.

I recommend you check out PCGS.com for a full description of grading standards, information on having your coins graded, population reports and some interesting articles.

Lastly there are shows coming up at Petersham, Canberra, Melbourne & Sydney. If you can make it in please drop by and say hello. We are also currently working out our EBay shop which will deal exclusively with PCGS graded material.
